WHAT ARE VIRAL WARTS?

Warts are non-cancerous growths on the skin caused by human papillomavirus (HPV).

HOW DOES IT SPREAD?

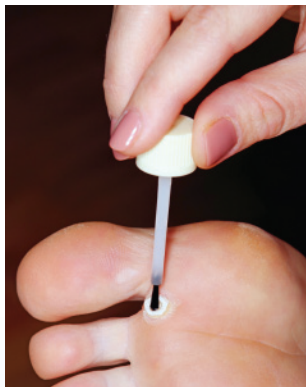
This is spread via skin to skin contact.

WHERE DOES IT OCCUR?

It is most commonly found on the bottom of the foot or fingers although it can potentially affect any part of the body.



TREATMENT OF VIRAL WARTS



1. Topical treatment

This is usually the first line of treatment. Medications can be used to remove dead skin cells and target the virus that are causing the warts.

2. Cryotherapy

Cryotherapy like HISTOFREEZER or liquid nitrogen can be utilised to remove persistent viral warts. Repeated treatments may be required.

3. Laser Vaporisation

Laser treatments are an effective method to remove persistent warts.
